

CIRCUIT MAP - V1 [30.11.2022]





Appendix L ISC Chapter IV Art. 2.c)

Drivers must use the track at all times and may not leave the track without a justifiable reason. For the avoidance of doubt, the white lines defining the track edges are considered to be part of the track but the kerbs are not.



The following principles will apply to any car that crosses the yellow line with four wheels


- a. It is the driver's responsibility to re-join the track in a safe way, and without gaining any advantage.
- b. A driver fighting for a position, the driver will come out behind.
- c. A driver side by side, the driver will come out behind.
- d. A driver defending in front will come out behind.
- e. A driver attacking by the outside that goes wide, will come out behind.
- f. A driver alone that crosses the yellow line must reduce the gap to the car behind, clearly indicating that there is no gain. This must be done before lintermediate 2.
- g. The stewards can apply the penalties foreseen or any other available to them by the ISC.
