The Stewards, having received a report from the Asian Le Mans Series Race Director, have considered the matter, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and have decided as follows:

**Facts** Contact between Car 84 and Car 22 in Turn 13.

Offence Alleged Breach of Article 9.1.11 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting

Regulations.

**Decision** No further action.

In turn 12 Car 84 moved to the inside of the turn which made Car 22 move to Reason

> the outside as it is much faster car, this gave Car 22 the inside line in turn 13 where Car 84 closed the space to Car 22 and both cars ended up making contact in the entry to turn 13. Considering it was a free practice session Car 22 could have chosen a better place to overtake a clearly slower car, and Car 84 could have left more space for Car 22. After considering all these facts, the stewards find that no driver could be found predominantly at fault for the

contact.

The Competitor is reminded of their right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA ISC and Art. 16.2.6 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting Regulations), in accordance with Art. 15 of the FIA ISC and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
