Session Race 1

Facts Contact between Car 90 and Car 99 in Turn 12 (15:02)

Offence Alleged Breach of Article 9.1.11 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting Regulations.

Decision Drive through penalty.

Reason Car 90 made an attempt to go past Car 99 on the inside of turn 12, however the attempt was made very late and car 99 did not have time to take avoiding action. As a result Car 90 made contact with Car 99 thereby making Car 99 spin. Car 90 was found to be predominantly at fault for the accident.

The Competitor is reminded of their right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA ISC and Art. 16.2.6 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting Regulations), in accordance with Art.15 of the FIA ISC and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.

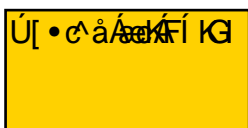
