Facts Contact between Car 8 and Car 55 at Turn 12 (16:45)


Offence Breach of Article 9.1.11 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting Regulations.
Causing a collision.

Decision Stop & Go 10 seconds and 4 points deducted from the driver's reserve points.


Reason The stewards, having reviewed the video footage, find car 8 fully responsible for the accident by not allowing space for a much faster car. While the Stop & Go 10 sec penalty is inconsequential due to car 8 having retired as a result of the incident, the stewards felt that it had to be given to reflect the seriousness of the incident.

The Competitor is reminded of their right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA ISC and Art. 16.2.6 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting Regulations), in accordance with Art.15 of the FIA ISC and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
