

PURPOSE OF THE REQUEST

Regulation

Article 12.2.2 states "When the car is stopped, in its dedicated stopping area, no part of the car must cover the longitudinal tape defining the area in top view"

In WEC and ELMS this rule is almost identical but states "*no part of the car must cover the lateral tape*". Please confirm, does longitudinal mean the tape that is parallel to the sides of the car, or parallel to the front of the car?
