

The Stewards, having received a report from the Asian Le Mans Series Race Director, have considered the following matter, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and have decided to impose the following penalty:

No / Driver 87 / Bo Yuan
Competitor Origine Motorsport
Session Qualifying – GT
Time 11:12
Facts Car 87 made contact with Car 98 at Turn 15, resulting in a red flag.
Offence Breach of Article 10.2.3 of the Asian Le Mans Sporting Regulations,
Decision All lap times set by Car 87 prior to the red flag are cancelled.
In addition, 1 penalty point is deducted (balance = 6).
Reason Car 87 made contact with Car 98 at Turn 15 and as a result caused a collision.
Car 87 was the sole cause of the red flag and is penalised accordingly.

The Competitor is reminded of their right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA ISC and Art. 7.4 of the Asian Le Mans Series Sporting Regulations), in accordance with Art.15 of the FIA ISC and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
