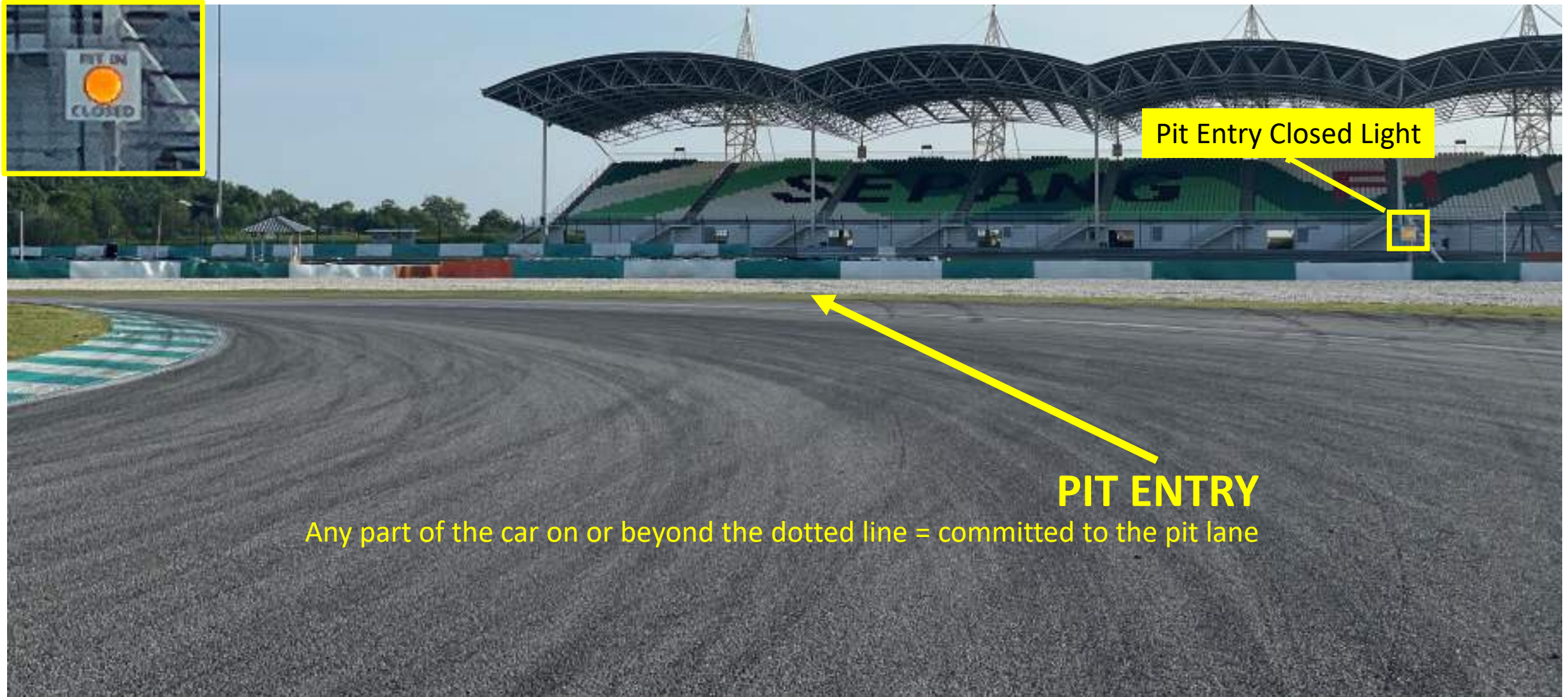

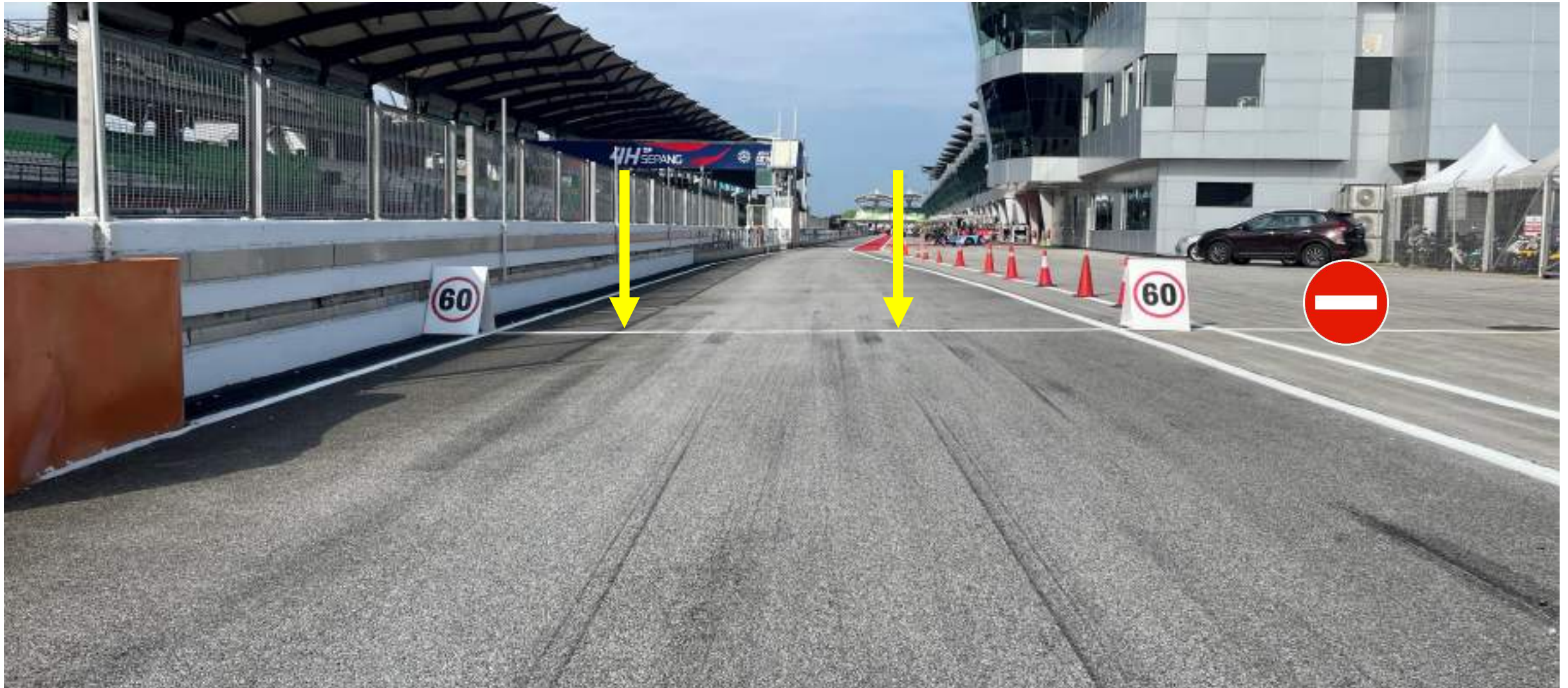

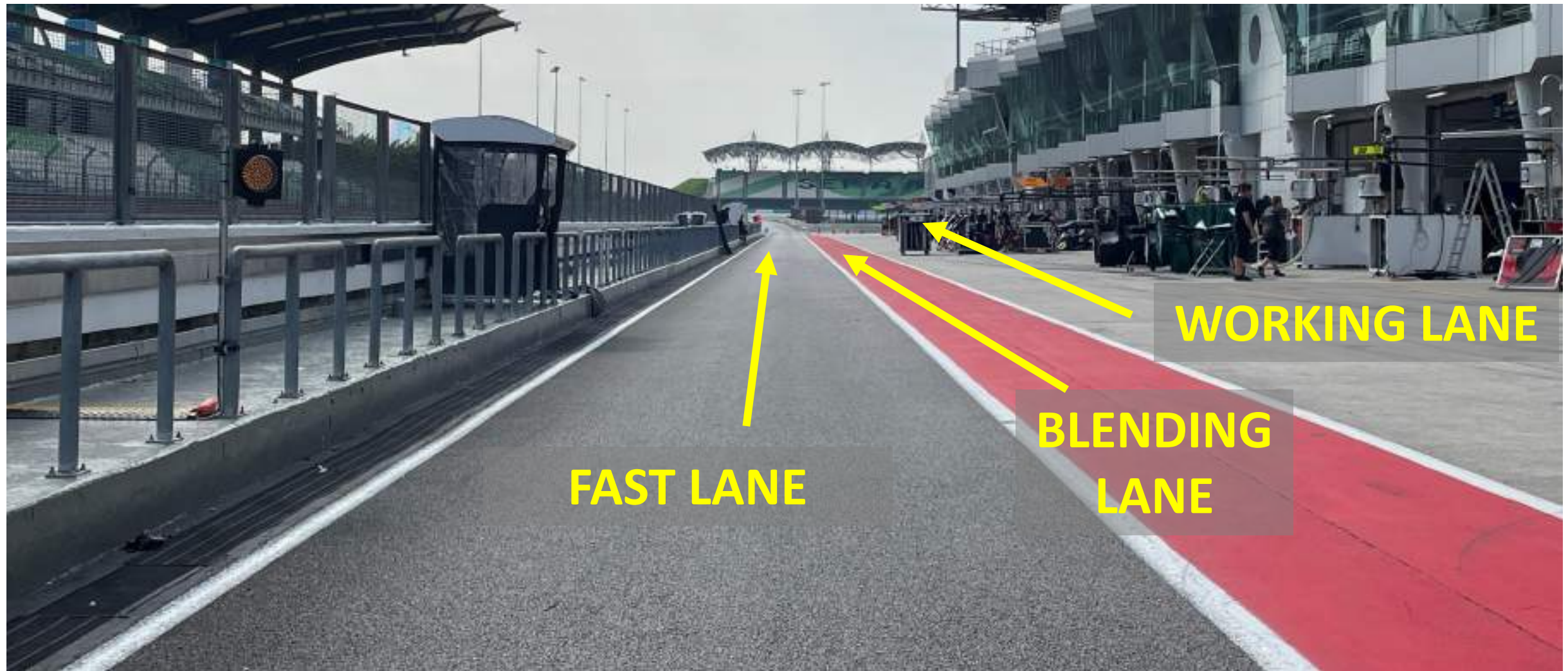

Appendix L ISC Chapter IV Art. 2.c)

FCY // SAFETY CAR – PIT ENTRY CLOSED LIGHT

- In case of failure of the hardware, Race Control, once made aware of the fact, will inform immediately the Competitors via radio and message on the timing monitors.
- For the purpose of Articles 14.5.2 (FCY) and 14.6.5 (SC), the pit entry closed light system is considered as a help for the driver.
- During the Safety Car procedures, it is the Competitors' responsibility to count the laps as detailed in Article 14.6.7.
- However, for the purpose of Article 12.1.1 if the light is activated, the light must be respected at any moment.



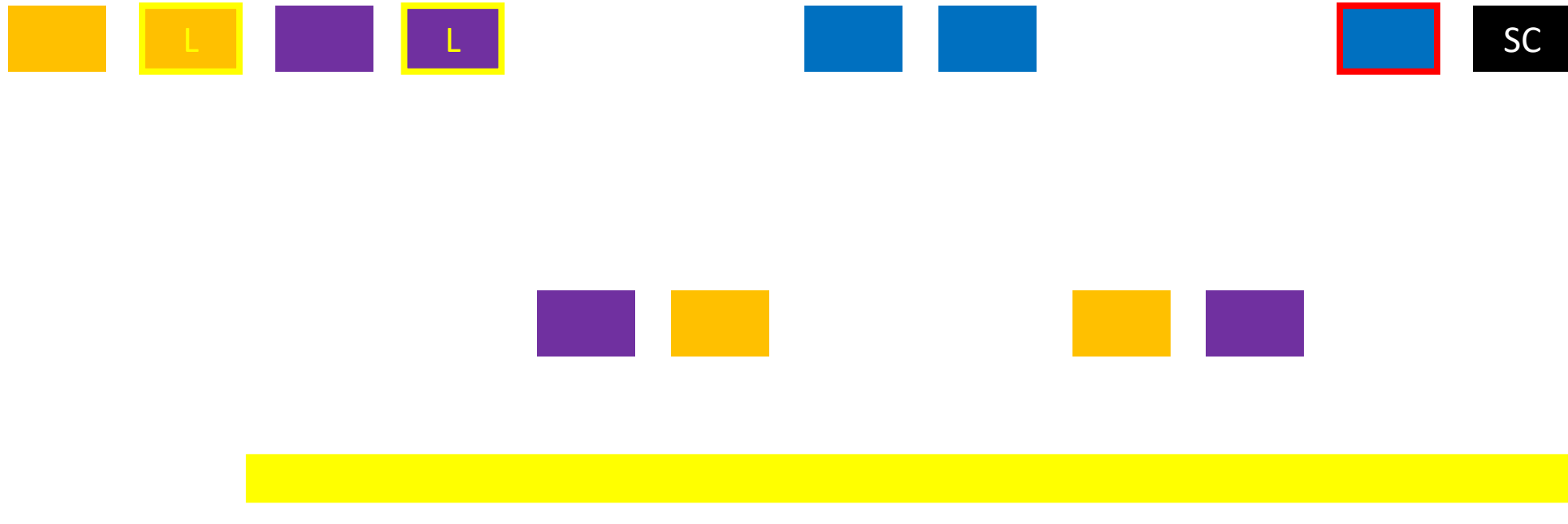

PREPARE FOR THE PASS AROUND*

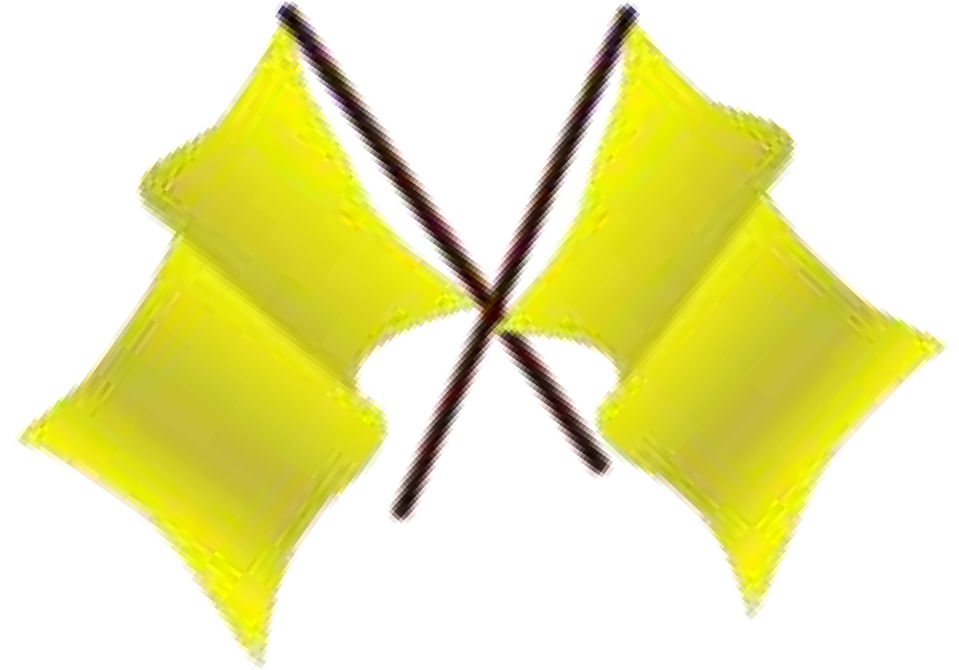


- Pass Around Eligibility established based on the last passing on a Sector Loop before Race Control announces 'Prepare for Pass Around'.
- If the leader of a category is in the pit lane at the moment the message 'Prepare for Pass Around' is announced → Eligibility is based on the next car from the category that was physically behind the leader on track in circulating order at the time the leader entered the pit lane.

During VSC, SC, FCY and RED FLAG procedures, any Marshal Post(s) that has any intervention in its sector will signal with double waved yellow and the relevant board



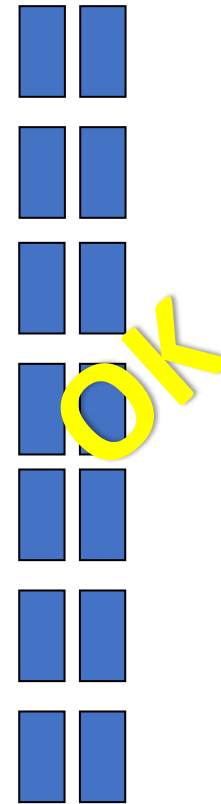
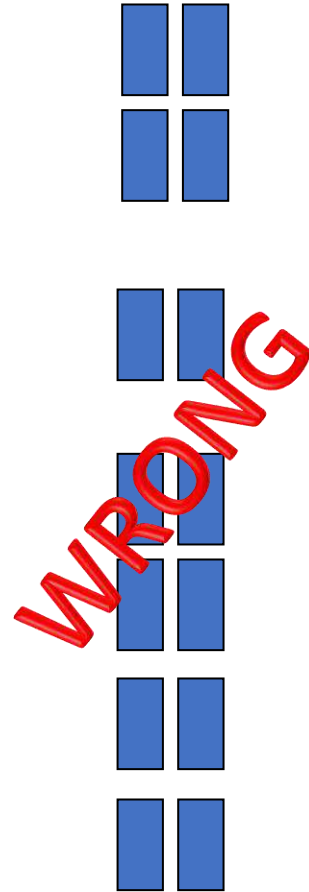
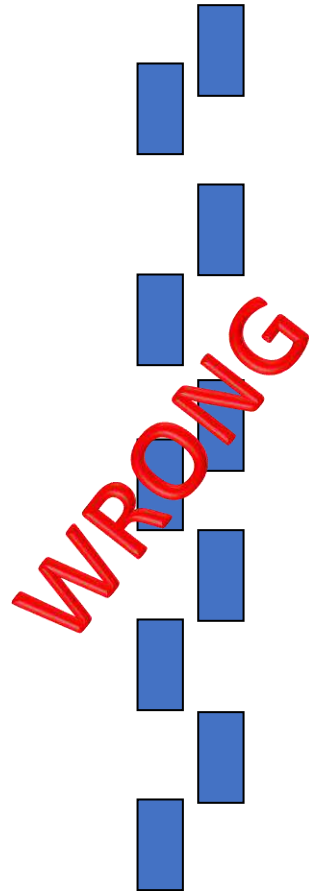
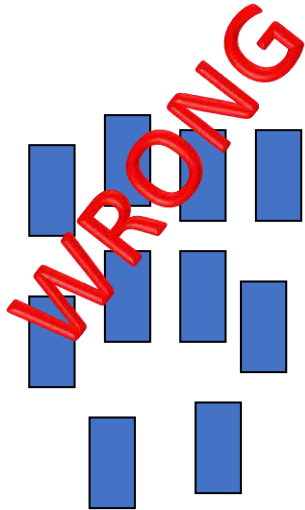
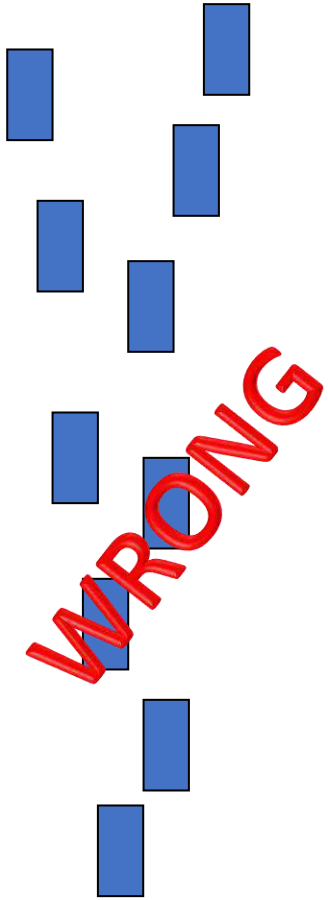
