1. Penalties / Car cockpit temperature management

Due to the forecasted temperatures for the weekend the following will apply:

- Pit lane penalties:
 - Any car that during a session or the race gets a Pit Lane penalty that causes the car to be immobilized for 30 seconds or more, once the car is stopped in its stopping position for the purpose of serving the penalty, the Right-Hand Side door may be opened, and the cockpit may be artificially ventilated.
 - This may only be done at a distance and such equipment may not be within the vertical perimeter of the car.
- Race:
 - During Red Flag Procedure(s) the mechanic with the Red armband will only be controlled concerning the “dress code” as long as he/she is in contact with the car (this includes holding any kind of device that interacts directly with the car).
 - If the mechanic stays away from the car(s) then the use of the dress code will not be mandatory.

2. Pit Exit White Line

For the purpose of article 4 d) of Chapter IV of Appendix L to the ISC, we hereby inform all drivers that race control will not be monitoring the first left-hand-side line of the pit exit road in the area indicated in the picture below.
