
The Stewards, having received a letter from the Competitor named above requesting approval for Car no. 43 driver Nick Cassidy to take part in Race 1 and 2 despite failing to achieve the required minimum lap time as per Article 10.1.2, have reviewed the matter, and have decided as follows:

N° / Driver: 43 / Nick Cassidy
Competitor: INTER EUROPOL COMPETITION
Session: After Free Practice 2
Time (fact): 17:30
Fact: The Driver of Car 43 (Cassidy) failed to achieve the minimum lap time as required by the Sporting Regulations.
Offence: Breach of Article 10.1.2 of ALMS Sporting Regulations
Decision: Driver Nick Cassidy is allowed to take part in Race 1 and 2.

Reason:

The car had mechanical issues in FP1 that resulted in the driver not being able to post a meaningful lap time. With the number of red flag interventions in FP2, coupled with the change of weather and track condition from dry to wet, the Panel of Stewards agreed that the driver effectively lost the opportunity to establish the required minimum lap time. After consulting and receiving the agreement of the Asian Le Mans Series Race Director, the Stewards have agreed that the driver is capable of achieving a meaningful lap time.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
