
The Stewards, having received a report from the Time Keepers, heard from the Competitors' Representative and the Driver concerned, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**N° / Driver:** 11 / James Roe  
**Competitor:** TF SPORT  
**Session:** Race 1  
**Time (fact):** 18:07  
**Fact:** Car 11 was alleged to have exceeded the maximum GT stint length (65 minutes).  
**Offence:** Alleged breach of Article 13.2 of ALMS Sporting Regulations  
**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:**

Car 11 was unable to comply with the maximum GT stint length of a maximum of 65 minutes as the pit lane was closed at the time at which he should have finished his driving stint. The Stewards, after reviewing the data provided by timekeeping as well as the circumstances that led to the situation, have decided that no penalty should be applied on this occasion.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
