The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.


**N° / Driver:** 87 / Bo Yuan  
**Competitor:** ORIGINE MOTORSPORT  
**Session:** Race 1  
**Time (fact):** 14:16  
**Fact:** Car 87 (Yuan) drove in a manner potentially dangerous to others by not maintaining the correct gap in the chain of cars behind the Safety Car.  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 2.10 of Appendix H of the International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** Reprimand to the Driver of Car 87. In addition, 2 points deducted (balance of 6 for the 2025-26 season).

**Reason:**

The Stewards examined video evidence. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that CCTV shows that on the exit of Turn 14, with the Safety Car's lights off, all the cars were in a line behind the Safety Car. Car 87, third in line, was seen to drop back thus creating a gap which was later established to be more than 20 car lengths from the two leading cars. Subsequently, Car 87 accelerated towards the entry of Turn 15 and all cars behind followed as the leader entered Turn 15. Car 87 and the cars following it caught up with the leader at a much higher speed, with Car 87 and all cars behind him having to take avoiding action to prevent a possible incident.

Car 87 is deemed to have failed to follow the regulations listed in Article 2.10 of Appendix H, FIA International Sporting Code.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
