The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representative and the Driver concerned (Summons 9), have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**N° / Driver:** 29 / Luciano Morano  
**Competitor:** FORESTIER RACING BY VPS  
**Session:** Free Practice 1  
**Time (fact):** 17:22  
**Fact:** Car 29 (Morano) went off track at Turn 5 and overtook Car 50 (C Bennett) and gained lasting advantage.  
**Offence:** Breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2 b of International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** Stop and Go plus 5 minutes to be served at the start of FP2. In addition, 1 point deducted (balance of 7 for the 2025-26 season).

**Reason:**

The Stewards summoned and heard the driver and team representative (Summons 9) and together they examined video evidence. Car 29, while following Car 50, exceeded track limits at Turn 3 in the course of an overtaking attempt.

The Stewards note that the Drivers' Briefing included clear and specific instructions regarding overtaking conduct at the aforementioned corner, with particular emphasis on remaining within track limits and avoiding the use of the run-off to facilitate overtaking manoeuvres.

Although the overtaking manoeuvre was completed at Turn 5, the Stewards determined that the pass was enabled by the advantage gained through leaving the track at Turn 3. The driver of Car 29 failed to adhere to the prescribed overtaking conduct outlined during the Drivers' Briefing.

Accordingly, a lasting advantage was obtained by exceeding track limits, which is not in compliance with the applicable Sporting Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
