The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representative (Summons 10) concerned, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

N° / Driver: 9 / Anthony Bartone
Competitor: GETSPEED
Session: Free Practice 2
Time (fact): 20:51
Fact: Car 9 failed to serve the time penalty (Decision 36) correctly.
Offence: Breach of Article 7.4.3 of ALMS Sporting Regulations

Decision:

Drive through for either of the Races, suspended for the remainder of this event.

Should the driver carry out a similar infringement (abusing track limits) at any time in either race at this event, the penalty will be imposed together with the penalty for the actual offence.

Reason:

Car 9 was serving a 5-minute stop-and-go penalty (Decision 36) for repeated abuse of track limits when it was noted that work was carried out on the car.

In accordance with the ALMS Sporting Regulations, no work is permitted on a car while a stop-and-go penalty is being served. The Stewards therefore determine that this constitutes a breach of the regulations.

As the session had concluded, the Stewards convert the penalty to a drive-through penalty, suspended until the end of the competition. A repeat of the same offence by the same driver (abuse of track limits) will activate this penalty along with any additional penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
