
The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representative, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Car 4 (Kurtz) was alleged to have performed an unsafe release.
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 12.1.2 of the ALMS Sporting Regulations
Decision: No further action.


Reason:

Video evidence shows no proof of an unsafe release. The Stewards heard separately from the pit lane marshal and the driver and team representative. The Stewards determine that the incident was the result of a misunderstanding between the pit lane marshal's signaling and the driver. The incident did not give rise to any safety concern that would warrant the imposition of a penalty. Accordingly, no further action is taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
