The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Car 74 (Lulham) was alleged to have overtaken Car 87 off track.
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2 b
Decision: No further action.


Reason:

The Stewards reviewed video footage. Multiple cars were approaching Turn 10, with Car 74 ahead of Car 87 and several other cars following. On entry to Turn 10, Car 74 adopted a wider racing line while Car 87 took a tighter line. As a result, the two cars continued through the corner running side by side.

During the manoeuvre, while Car 87 utilised the full width of the track, the cars remained side by side, with Car 74 maintaining a slight advantage over Car 87 throughout. Car 74 subsequently ran out of road and rejoined the circuit ahead of Car 87 and the following cars.

Having reviewed the incident, the Stewards determine that no lasting advantage was gained and that the situation constituted hard but fair racing. Accordingly, no further action is taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
