The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**N° / Driver:** 47 / Antonio Fuoco  
**Competitor:** CETILAR RACING  
**Session:** Race 1  
**Time (fact):** 18:22  
**Fact:** Car 47 went off track at Turn 6 and gained lasting advantage, not following the Race Director instructions.  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 12.2.1.i of International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** 10 seconds to be added to total race time. In addition, 1 point deducted (balance of 7 for the 2025-26 season).


**Reason:**

The Stewards reviewed CCTV footage. On the approach to Turn 6, Car 47 had completed an overtaking manoeuvre on Car 26 and was thereafter defending its position from ahead. Car 47 subsequently aborted the corner, cut Turn 6 and rejoined the circuit after the exit of Turn 7.


In accordance with Race Director's Event Notes No. 10, a car that leaves the track is required to rejoin behind the car it was ahead of. In this case, Car 47 was required to rejoin behind Car 26.

The Stewards therefore determine that Car 47 failed to comply with Race Director's Event Notes No. 10.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
